Electronics

Strings

Strings can alter the playability and tone of your guitar.

It's important to know which type and gauge of strings come with your particular model. Most Taylor steel-string acoustic and electric guitars feature D'Addario strings. All Taylor nylon-string models feature D'Addario Pro-Arté Carbon strings. The GS Mini® Bass features custom D'Addario strings developed exclusively for the instrument (no other strings can be used). Humidity Control

Proper humidification is critical to your guitar's health.

Because your Taylor guitar is crafted from wood, storing it in an environment with a healthy humidity level — between 40 and 60 percent RH — is the most important aspect of maintaining it. Overly dry or humid conditions will cause the wood to shrink or swell, and potentially crack, and humidity-related damage is not covered under warranty.

If you're not sure of the humidity level where you store your guitar, we recommend the purchase of a digital hygrometer to monitor the humidity. Our Contact & Care page explains how to keep your guitar properly humidified.
